Elpida Announces Akita Elpida is Back in Operation

Tokyo, Japan, March 16, 2011 – Elpida Memory, Inc. announced today that Akita Elpida Memory Inc., a packaging and testing subsidiary of Elpida, resumed operations following the restoration of the electrical power supply. Akita Elpida had not been in operation due to a power outage caused by the massive

earthquake that struck northeast Japan on March 11.

The earthquake and subsequent related power outage did not cause any injury to Akita Elpida employees

or damage to facilities.

Because Elpida outsources more than 90% of its packaging and testing operations to overseas firms, the

impact on company earnings due to the shutdown of Akita Elpida is expected to be minimal.
