



Rexchip earns AEO certificate from Taiwan Customs

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Rexchip Electronics (4932) is a leading DRAM manufacturer in Taiwan. Its 300mm fabrication facility utilizes the most advanced technology to manufacture high density and high performance DRAM products. Today, Rexchip announces that it earns AEO (Authorized Economic Operator) certificate from Taiwan Customs. Be a member of AEOs, Rexchip will enjoy the privilege of simplified, rapid customs clearance.

An AEO is defined as: "a party involved in the international movement of goods in whatever function that has been approved by or on behalf of a national Customs administration as complying with WCO SAFE." In May 2010, Rexchip was firstly recommended by CTSP (Central Taiwan Science Park Administration), and became the second company who applied for AEO certification in Central Taiwan Science Park. Afterward, Rexchip submitted the AEO application to Taiwan Customs officially in August in the same year, passed the physical evaluation in October and earned the AEO certificate in November. During the evaluation process, Rexchip fulfilled the AEO criteria through providing qualified documents and completing the validation of the safety measures in terms of our producing management system, working environment, and transportation.

Rexchip is the eighth company which earned the AEO certificate in Taiwan, and is also the first one in DRAM industry. Mr. Stephen Chen, President of Rexchip Electronics Corp., stated that we would like to appreciate the strong recommendation from CTSP, so that we can earn this honor. This record proves that Rexchip is a company which possesses excellent compliance record, healthy financial structure and world-class factory management.
