- The Compensation Committee certified achievement of the pre-established performance goals at a level resulting in a vest of 100% of the total target shares under the PE Ratio performance-based restricted stock units previously awarded on October 16, 2018. As reported at grant, the performance-based restricted stock unit could result in a payout that varies from 0% to an aggregate of 200% of target shares under all related awards based on actual achievement of the goals.
- The Compensation Committee certified achievement of the pre-established performance goals at a level resulting in a vest of 67% of the total target shares under the FCF performance-based restricted stock units previously awarded on October 16, 2018. - Each performance-based restricted stock unit represents the right to receive, following vesting, shares of common stock based upon the achievement of pre-established performance metrics related to FCF over a 3-year performance period beginning August 31, 2018 and ending on September 2, 2021 (payout is from 0% up to a 200% aggregate limit on the total target shares that may be received under the performance-based restricted stock units awarded on October 16, 2018), and certification of such performance by the Compensation Committee.
- Each performance-based restricted stock unit represents the right to receive, following vesting, shares of common stock based upon the achievement of pre-established performance metrics related to PE Ratio

over a 3-year performance period beginning August 31, 2018 and ending on September 2, 2021 (payout is from 0% up to a 200% aggregate limit on the total target shares that may be received under the performance-based restricted stock units awarded on October 16, 2018), and certification of such performance by the Compensation Committee.
